"CAJAL DREAMS EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS"

In an effort to help these bright students shape their dreams, CNRF has initiated a very special scholarship program. Starting this year CNRF will hold a painting and essay competition for special needs educational institutions in India. From these schools students, two students will be selected for the scholarship. The painting competition is for the students in the age group less than 10 years. The first three students shall receive special awards.

Theme for the Painting competition: **My dreams**. The paintings will be evaluated based on the creativity and overall message of the same. The students shall be invited to the award ceremony.

The other category is of **Cajal Dreams Educational Scholarships**, which comprises of an essay competition with the theme as following: Your ambition in life: How would you like to contribute to your society, nation and humanity as whole. The basis of evaluation will be done on the foresightedness, creativity, organization of thought and relevance to the proposed theme. All the awarded students shall be invited to attend the inaugural ceremony along with their parents to be held on 31st August 2008 at the following address:

The winner of the Cajal Dreams Educational Scholarships 2008-09 shall be awarded a stipend of **1000 Rupees per month** to cover educational and other essential expenses for the next school year **2008-09**, **one time cash award of Rs. 1000/-** plus a certificate from the Foundation. The Foundation shall conduct reviews to evaluate the improvement of the student in the following year after six months. Satisfactory remarks and assessment from the evaluators and the educators shall lead to further extension of the award term. All the rights for selection and code of conduct rests with the foundation.
